

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

SWASH[®] PERINEUM GLOVES 4 & 8-pack

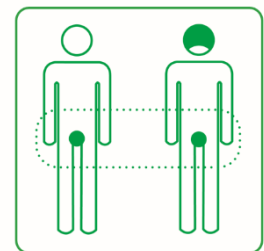
User: Professional or health care provider

Intended purpose:

Swash[®] Perineum Gloves are intended for perineal care of incontinent patients as a measure to prevent skin damage associated with exposure to urine or stool (IAD) or as a measure to manage such skin damage (IAD) in an early stage.

Supporting materials:

- Disposable gloves
- Rubbish bin
- Swash[®] Cleansing Wipes or other pre-moistened wipes, tissue paper (if necessary)
- Incontinence material (if necessary)
- Clean clothing and / or linens (if necessary)
- Microwave oven (if necessary)



Instructions for use:

Use sufficient gloves to clean the soiled perineum area (see pictogram). If desired, the package can be heated in the microwave. Check the temperature before use. Use each package for one person only. See below for detailed procedure.

Detailed procedure:

Swash[®] Perineum Gloves can be stored on the ward in a central place or next to the bed of the care recipient. The Swash[®] Perineum Gloves can be used both heated and at room temperature.

- 1 If preferred, heat the Swash[®] Perineum Gloves. The recommended temperature is achieved by heating the package at a maximum of 800 watts in a microwave oven for 15 seconds (4-pack) or 20 seconds (8-pack).
- 2 Tell the care recipient what you are going to do and keep communicating throughout the washing procedure.
- 3 Before starting, wash your hands and put on a pair of disposable gloves.
- 4 Have the care recipient lie in a supine position with a pillow under his/her head. Have the care recipient remove his/her outerwear; if necessary, help the care recipient with this. Take the privacy of the care recipient into consideration.
- 5 Remove wet and dirty incontinence material.
- 6 If necessary, large amounts of faeces can be gently removed with Swash[®] Cleansing Wipes or pre-moistened wipes, tissues etc.
- 7 Open the package of Swash[®] Perineum Gloves and take out a glove. Check the temperature of the wipe. Note: disposable gloves reduce your sensitivity to heat.
- 8 Wash the genitals with a Swash[®] Perineum Glove. The skin dries by itself through the evaporation of the lotion. If necessary, dry the skin folds by blotting with a tissue paper.
- 9 Ask the care recipient to turn onto his / her side and offer support if necessary. Clean the soiled perineum region (the buttocks and coccyx) of the care recipient with a Swash[®] Perineum Glove. Use as many gloves as necessary for the removal of all the faeces and / or urine from the skin. Preferably, place the used Swash[®] Perineum Gloves within the incontinence material.
- 10 For an optimal result, use a clean Swash[®] Perineum Glove for a final wash. It will leave a protective layer on the skin.

- 11 Inspect the perineum region for Incontinence Associated Dermatitis and other skin condition variables.
- 12 Give the care recipient new, clean and dry incontinence material. Change the bedding if wet or soiled and dress the care recipient again and put him / her in the desired position.
- 13 Throw the empty package of Swash® and the gloves in the bin. **DO NOT FLUSH Swash® Perineum Gloves / Swash® Cleansing Wipes down the toilet!**
- 14 Report any changes in the condition of the skin after the perineum washing.
- 15 Repeat this procedure after every urinary or faecal incontinence episode.

ATTENTION:

- At all times, make sure to take the feelings, comfort and privacy of the patient into consideration.
- Each package is to be used for only **one** person.
- It is strongly recommended to use up an opened package within 48 hours. If there are gloves left in the package, please write down the date and time on the pack and use the gloves for the same patient within a 48 hour period.
- Avoid the contact with the eyes.
- Only suitable for external use.
- If Swash® Perineum Gloves are heated according to the instructions on the package, it is important to check the temperature of the gloves before they are used on the skin. Do NOT use immediately if they are too hot. Remember that wearing disposable gloves reduces the sensitivity to heat. Pay special attention to checking the temperature with infants or persons who cannot react or people with a sensitive skin.
- **Do not flush the washcloths down the toilet. Throw the empty package of Swash® and the gloves in the bin.**

CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

- If the care recipient refuses the use thereof
- If it is known that the care recipient is sensitive or allergic to one or more of the ingredients
- On non-intact skin & open wounds
